- Research community and interest groups relevant to Dublin Fringe Festival programme
- Outreach and contacting community and interest groups to promote relevant Dublin Fringe Festival shows
- Support PR consultant and PR manager in promotional activity
- Assist during the festival as needed to support PR & Marketing teams
- Refresh and renew press contact lists
- Deal with media, internal and partner enquiries in an efficient and professional way
- Collate press clippings and ensure that all media mentions are filed in an orderly manner
- Support PR & Publicity manager with image requests
- Ad hoc marketing admin tasks
